



Vet to Vet Consults For Behavior Support

What are these?

- Vet to Vet behavior consults are conducted by phone between one of the board certified veterinary behaviorists at the Animal Behavior Clinic of New Jersey and the patient's attending veterinarian.
- Consults may include discussion of possible medications, initial management strategies the clients should implement, and or answer any questions the veterinarian may have about that particular case.
- Short videos or short histories can be reviewed during the 30 minute vet to vet. Any short videos (e.g less than one minute) can be emailed to info@animalbehaviorclinicnj.com.
- A written summary from the vet to vet consult is *not* provided. It is the responsibility of the primary care veterinarian to take notes.
- Any treatment recommended is at the sole discretion of the primary veterinarian.

How much does it cost?

- Consults are scheduled for 30 minutes and are billed at \$175.00 directly to the veterinary clinic.
- If supplemental materials need to be reviewed prior to the consult such as medical records, behavior history, or video, there is an additional charge of \$80.00/15 minutes of time spent in review. Materials must be received 72 hours in advance of the scheduled consult.
- It is the responsibility of the primary veterinarian to take notes.

What if I need more help on a particular case after the first vet to vet consult?

- Please keep in mind any further management of the case for which help is needed, please either refer the client for a full behavior consult with one of the board certified veterinary behaviorists or set up another vet2 vet consult.

Please note we do full virtual behavior consults in addition to in person behavior consults for clients as well. A full behavior consult is always preferred but we appreciate that not everyone is able to pursue a full consult.
